He became a member of Linden Acre Lodge of MMM No. 1568 on 3rd July 1981, a founder member of Cranley Lodge of MMM No. 1616 on 22nd April 1985 and was Installed as Worshipful Master on 9th April 1990, became a member of Charles Wilkinson Lodge of MMM No. 1657 on 10th February 1989 and subsequently became an Honorary Member of a further two Lodges in the Province.

He was appointed Assistant Provincial Grand Master of the Berkshire and Oxfordshire Province until the Provinces split in 1992 and was then appointed as Deputy Provincial Grand Master of the Province of Berkshire on 11th October 1994 until the 13th June 2002 when he was Installed as the Provincial Grand Master for the Province of Berkshire, a position he held until his retirement on 14th June 2007.
