

If your dilemma was figuring out how you were going to watch the Rugby World Cup Final and attend the consecration of Spirit of Rugby Lodge of Mark Master Masons, fear not. The bar at Mark Masons' Hall will be open from 8.30am and will be screening the match. Even better, bacon rolls, hash browns, tea and coffee will be available from 10am. The consecration will now take place once the celebrations are complete.

East Lancashire Order of the Secret Monitor donates £2,000 to Springhill Hospice.

The hospice is a 16 bed in-patient unit on the outskirts of Rochdale. Opened by Princess Anne, it recently celebrated 30 years of offering specialist end of life care for over 100 patients a year.

Only partly funded by the NHS, two thirds of its financial needs have to be raised by supporters, costing around £7,000 per day to keep going.

Chief Executive Julie Haliwell was absolutely delighted when Frank Smith, the Provincial Grand Supreme Ruler of the OSM in East Lancashire gave a donation of £2,000 to the Hospice.

Julie explained that the hospice has recently run the 'Comfort for All' appeal and the money donated by the members would be used for the purchase of a new specialist bed, mattress and chair. This equipment is designed with the maximum comfort for the patient in mind.

The care offered by Springhill extends to outside the hospice building, with holistic care and support offered to patients in the wider community around Rochdale, as well as counselling support for the whole family during the very sad and distressful bereavement period.



New Provincial Prior Installed in West Yorkshire

Castle Grove Masonic Hall in Headingley, Leeds was fully packed on Saturday 26 October to support the Installation of R.E.Kt. Hearl Lenton (formerly Sub-Prior in charge) as the new Provincial Prior for the Province of West Yorkshire.

The twenty-four Preceptories of the Povince proudly paraded their respective banners (several representing Preceptories over two hundred years old) before the Grand Master, who then went on to Install R.E.Kt. Lenton. The new Provincial Prior in turn Installed V.E.Kt. Tony Wilkinson as his Provincial Sub-Prior. It was a wonderful meeting followed by excellent

festivities in a warm atmosphere.
