

The Grand Council of Royal and Select Masters

Grand Master's Address and list of this year's recipients



The Most Illustrious Grand Master was pleased to confer the Rank of Custodian of the Ninth Arch upon two Companions in Tuesday's Grand Ranks.

They were R.III.Comp. Brian Anthony Vickers and R.III.Comp. Graham Smith, FRICS.

Brian was admitted into the Order in Matier Council No. 3 in the District of London in April 1974 and has held memberships of Councils across three different Districts plus two unattached Councils. He was first appointed to Grand Rank as Past Grand Conductor of the Council in 1994, promoted to Past Grand Lecturer in 2002 and was Installed as District Grand Master for London in June 2007, a role he carried out

#### diligently until 2012.

Also in 1974, in December, Graham was admitted into the Order in Invicta Council
No. 14 in the District of Kent, becoming Deputy District Grand Master in December
1996 followed by Promotion to District Grand Master in October 2002. Upon
retirement from that Office in 2007 most people might have opted to take things easy
but Graham went on to become Grand Inspector of Jamaica and the Cayman Islands
in July 2012, a post he still holds today.

Both of these Companions have given long and devoted service to the Order and this Promotion is a recognition of their support and dedication over the years.

In congratulating the new Mark Province of Sussex ProvGM on his appoinment, we failed to give him his full and correct name.




